Maureen O'Connor, who pointed out that on November 22, 2024, the Advisory Group of Experts conducted a written assignment of the candidates as part of the stage of assessing their level of competence in the field of law and, then, in accordance with the AGE Methodology, within 15 days after the completion of the written assignment of all candidates, the Advisory Group should decide on the need for additional interviews.

Yaroslav Romaniuk and Hanna Suchocka who informed that being acknowledged with the candidates' written answers the Advisory Group of Experts has enough information to continue evaluating the candidates' competence level without conducting additional interviews.

Oksana Vasylchenko who proposed not to conduct additional interviews for assessing the level of competence in the field of law of candidates for the position of judge of the Constitutional Court of Ukraine.
